








PLAN SHOWING LOCATION OF LAND

BEING SATISFIED that a determination of native title in the terms sought by the parties is within the power of the Court, and it appearing appropriate to do so by consent of the parties,

PURSUANT TO SS 87(1) AND (2) AND 94A OF THE NATIVE TITLE ACT 1993 (CTH), THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

- 1. There be a determination that native title exists in the terms set out below (the **Determination**).
- 2. The native title as determined is to be held on trust by Yaegl Traditional Owners Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC.
- 3. Yaegl Traditional Owners Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC is to:
 - (a) be the prescribed body corporate for the purposes of s 57(1) of the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth) (the **NTA**); and

- (b) perform the functions set out in s 57(1) of the NTA and the *Native Title* (*Prescribed Bodies Corporate*) Regulations 1999 (Cth).
- 4. There be no order as to costs.

THE COURTS NOTES THAT:

- A. On 27 November 1996, the Applicant in proceeding NSD6052 of 1998 made a native title determination application ('Yaegl People's #1 Application') that relates to an area of land and waters including the waters and estuaries of the Clarence River from Harwood to the mouth of the river at Yamba on the north coast of New South Wales, the subject of a proposed determination of native title ('Claim Area').
- B. The parties have reached an agreement as to the terms of the determination of native title to be made in relation to the Claim Area.
- C. The terms of the agreement involve the making of orders by consent for a determination pursuant to sections 87 and 94A of the NTA that native title exists in relation to certain land or waters in the Claim Area.
- D. Pursuant to sections 87 and 94A of the NTA, the parties have filed a Minute of Proposed Consent Determination of Native Title which reflects the terms of the agreement reached by them.
- E. The Applicant has nominated the Yaegl Traditional Owners Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC pursuant to section 56(2) of the NTA to hold the determination native title on trust for the common law native title holders.
- F. The Yaegl Traditional Owners Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC has consented in writing to hold the rights and interests comprising the native title on trust for the common law holders and to perform the functions of a registered native title body corporation under the NTA.

Note: Entry of orders is dealt with in Rule 39.32 of the Federal Court Rules 2011.

THE DETERMINATION

Existence of native title

- The Determination Area comprises the areas of land or waters described in Schedule
 One and shaded green on the plan in Schedule Two.
- 2. Native title exists in relation to the areas of land or waters in the Determination Area in the manner set out in paragraphs 5 to 8.
- 3. Native title has been extinguished in the land and waters described in Schedule Three ('the Extinguished Areas').

Native title holders

- 4. Native title in the Determination Area is held by the Yaegl People who comprise all the descendants of the following apical ancestors:
 - (a) Dugald Cameron (who was born in Chatsworth Island around 1870);
 - (b) Jack Freeburn (who was born in Yamba around 1868);
 - (c) Sailor Morris (who was born in Chatsworth Island around 1831);
 - (d) Nodo Combo (who was born in Yamba around 1859); and
 - (e) Rose Combo nee Yamba and also known as Rosie Yamba (who was born in Yamba around 1856);

and persons adopted or incorporated into the families of those persons and who identify as and are accepted as Yaegl People in accordance with Yaegl traditional laws and customs (and the biological descendants of any such adopted or incorporated persons).

Nature and extent of native title rights and interests

- 5. Subject to paragraphs 6 to 8, the nature and extent of the native title rights are:
 - (a) the right to enter, travel over and remain on a non-permanent basis on the Determination Area;
 - (b) the right to live on the land, to camp, to erect shelters, and to move about the land in the Determination Area but not extending to a right to permanently occupy or possess the land;
 - (c) the right to engage in cultural activities, to conduct ceremonies, to hold meetings, and to participate in cultural practices relating to birth and death in the Determination Area;

- (d) the right to hunt in the Determination Area;
- (e) the right to fish in the Determination Area;
- (f) the right to take and use the water of the Determination Area for personal, domestic and communal purposes (including cultural purposes) but not extending to a right to control the use and flow of the water in any rivers or lakes which flow through or past or are situated within the land of two or more occupiers;
- (g) the right to gather and use the natural resources in the Determination Area including food, medicinal plants, timber, stone, charcoal, ochre and resin as well as materials for fabricating tools and hunting implements and making artwork and musical instruments:
- (h) the right to light fires on the Determination Area for domestic purposes, but not for the clearance of vegetation;
- (i) the right to share, offer and exchange traditional resources derived from the Determination Area;
- (j) the right to have access to, maintain and protect from physical harm, sites and places of importance in the Determination Area which are of significance to Yaegl People under their traditional laws and customs;
- (k) the right to teach on the Determination Area the physical, cultural and spiritual attributes of places and areas of importance on or in the Determination Area; and
- (l) the right to be accompanied on the Determination Area by persons who, though not native title holders, are:
 - (i) spouses, partners or parents of native title holders, together with their children and grandchildren;
 - (ii) people whose presence is required under traditional laws and customs for the performance of cultural activities, practices or ceremonies; and
 - (iii) people requested by the native title holders to assist in, observe or record cultural activities, practices or ceremonies.
- 6. The native title rights and interests referred to in paragraphs 5(a) to (l) are not exclusive.

General qualifications on native title rights and interests

- 7. Native title does not exist in:
 - (a) minerals as defined in the *Mining Act 1992* (NSW) and the *Mining Regulation* 2010 (NSW); and
 - (b) petroleum as defined in the *Petroleum (Onshore) Act 1991* (NSW) and the *Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Act 1982* (NSW).
- 8. The native title rights and interests in the Determination Area do not confer:
 - (a) possession, occupation, use or enjoyment to the exclusion of all others; and
 - (b) any right to control public access to, or public use of, the land or waters in the Determination Area.
- 9. The native title rights and interests in the Determination Area are subject to and exercisable in accordance with:
 - (a) the laws of the State of New South Wales and of the Commonwealth;
 - (b) the traditional laws acknowledged and traditional customs observed by the Yaegl People; and
 - (c) the terms of any Indigenous Land Use Agreement which may at any time be registered by the National Native Title Tribunal in respect of any part of the Determination Area.

Nature and extent of other interests

10. The other interests in relation to the Determination Area are the interests described in Schedule Four ('Other Interests').

Relationship between native title rights and other interests

- 11. The relationship between the native title rights and interests in the Determination Area and the Other Interests is that:
 - (a) the Other Interests continue to have effect;
 - (b) the Other Interests co-exist with the native title rights and interests;
 - (c) the native title holders do not have the right to control access to or the use of the land or waters by the holders of the Other Interests, acting in accordance with those Other Interests; and
 - (d) to the extent of any inconsistency, the Other Interests and any activity that is required or permitted by or under the exercise of a right conferred or held under the Other Interests, while they are in existence, prevail over but do not

extinguish the native title rights and interests and any exercise of those native title rights and interests.

Definitions

- 12. In this Determination and the associated orders, unless the contrary intention appears:
 - **'Claim Area'** means the land or waters subject to native title determination application NSD6052 or 1998 (The Yaegl People's #1 Application).
 - **'Determination Area'** means the land and waters described in Schedule One and depicted on the plan in Schedule Two.
 - **'Extinguished Areas'** means the land and waters described in Schedule Three and depicted on the plan in Schedule Two.
 - 'laws of the State of New South Wales and of the Commonwealth' include statutes, regulations and other subordinate legislation and the common law.
 - 'Native Title Act' means the Native Title Act 1993 (Cth).
 - **'native title rights and interests'** means the rights and interests described in paragraph 5.
 - 'Other Interests' means the described in Schedule Four.
 - 'validated' means acts validated in accordance with the *Native Title Act* or the *Native Title (New South Wales) Act 1994* (NSW).
 - 'Yaegl People' means the native title holders described in paragraph 4.
 - **'Yaegl Traditional Owners Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC'** means Yaegl Traditional Owners Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC incorporated under the *Corporations (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander) Act* 2006 (Cth).
- 13. If a word or expression is not defined in the Determination or the associated orders, but is defined in the *Native Title Act*, then it has the meaning given to it in the *Native Title Act*.

Schedule One

Description of the Determination Area

- 1. The Determination Area is comprised of the areas of land and waters identified in paragraph 4 below.
- 2. The Determination Area is also depicted on the plan in Schedule Two. For the sake of clarity, it is confirmed that the Determination Area does not include the unclaimed areas of land or waters in respect of which native title does not exist by reason of extinguishment.
- 3. In the event of any inconsistency between the written description provided in paragraph 4 in this Schedule and the plan in Schedule Two, the written description shall prevail.
- 4. The area covered by the Determination is the lands and waters including the tidal water within the described area below:
 - Note for interpretation of description: In this description all references to river banks (right, left or by cardinal points), foreshores and the South Pacific Ocean relate to their position at the Mean High Water Mark. All references to river banks relate to the right or left bank as the river flows. Due to the number of channels and lagoons that are tidal and do not flow in a specific direction reference to their banks is by cardinal points. DP refers to Deposited Plan.
 - (a) Commencing on the right bank of the Clarence River at the eastern extremity of the breakwater that meets the South Pacific Ocean. Thence by the general right bank of the Clarence River, aforesaid, upwards to the general eastern bank of Oyster Channel. By the general eastern bank generally southerly and the foreshore of Wooloweyah Lagoon to the general south western bank of Palmer Channel. By that general south western bank generally north westerly to the general right bank of Clarence River, aforesaid. Again, by the general right bank of Clarence River and the right bank of James Creek upwards to its intersection with the prolongation of the general southern boundary of lot 1 of DP650930 (being the tidal limit of James Creek). By that prolongation generally north westerly to the left bank of James Creek, aforesaid. By that left bank downwards to again the general right bank of Clarence River upwards to its intersection with the eastern edge of Pacific Highway. By that eastern edge of the Pacific Highway, aforesaid, to the general left bank of Clarence River.

By that left bank downwards and the general southern and western banks of Palm Channel generally westerly and generally northerly and the general right bank of Narho Creek upwards to the north west corner of lot 2 of DP594030.

Thence by an unnamed road generally north easterly to the left bank of Narho Creek, aforesaid. By that left bank downwards and the general western bank of Palm Channel, aforesaid, generally northerly to the general left bank of Clarence River. By that general left bank downwards to the general southern bank of Middle Channel. By that general southern bank generally westerly and the general south eastern bank of Serpentine Channel generally south westerly to its intersection with the general north eastern edge of Pacific Highway, aforesaid. By that general north eastern edge generally north westerly to the general north western bank of Serpentine Channel. By that general north western bank generally north easterly to the general western bank of Middle Channel, aforesaid. By that general western bank generally northerly to the right bank of North Arm. By that right bank upwards to its intersection with the north eastern edge of Pacific Highway, aforesaid (at Mororo Bridge). By that north eastern edge north westerly to the left bank of North Arm. By that left bank, the foreshore of Shallow Inlet and again the left bank of North Arm downwards and the right bank of Woolpack Gully upwards to the southern edge of Iluka Road. By that southern edge easterly to the left bank of Woolpack Gully. By that left bank and again the left bank of north arm downwards, the right bank of Esk River upwards to the general northern boundary of lot Pt.94 of DP751394 (at Billy Weily Bridge). By the prolongation of that northern boundary easterly to the left bank of Esk River, aforesaid.


By that left bank downwards, the general northern boundary of Woram Channel easterly, the left bank of North Arm downwards, the foreshore of Saltwater Inlet, again the left bank of North Arm and the left bank of Clarence River downwards to the foreshore of Iluka Bay. By that foreshore and again the left bank of Clarence River downward to the eastern end of the northern breakwater at the South Pacific Ocean.

Thence by a line to the point of commencement.

- (b) The following islands that lie within the above definition are excluded from the Determination Area:
 - (i) Dart Island, Wangainan Island, Periko Island, Ano Island, Corokos Island, Joss Island, Micalo Island, Palmers Island, Panibona Island, Tomayen Island, Romiaka Island, Maritzos Island, Thorny Island, Eureka Island, Ungandam Island, Yargai Island, Whyuna Island, Sleeper Island, Araiel Island, Turkey Island, Gourd Island, Palm Island, Goodwood Island, Freeburn Island, Rabbit Island, Arris Island, Bolorobo Island, Esk Island, Nihill Island, Narrabarribi Island, Garden Island, Woolbin Island; and
 - (ii) three unnamed islands:
 - (A) An unnamed island enclosed by the tidal waters of North Arm, Esk River and Woram Channel;
 - (B) An unnamed island within Micalo Channel situated south west of Panibona Island and north east of Palmers Island; and
 - (C) An unnamed island within Clarence River situated south east of Palm Island.



WESTERN LANDS LEASE.

Edward VIII, by the Grace of God, of Great Britain, Ireland, and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas, King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India.

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:—

Thereas certain Crown Lands in the Western Division of Our State of New South Wales were duly set apart
for disposal by way of lease exclusively to holders of lands under any tenure situated in the Central and/or Western Division within a reasonable working distance of such lands.
for the purpose ofgrazing
under the provisions of the Western Lands Act of 1901 as amended by subsequent Acts (hereinafter called the said Acts) AND WHEREAS HUGH CURPHEY, "Hughdale", Balranald
in Our said State
did on the sixteenth day of February
19 44 make an application under the provisions of the said Acts for a Lease of the land hereinafter mentioned and all things required by law have been done to enable a Lease of such land to be duly granted AND WHEREAS
Our Minister for Lands of Our said State has granted to the said
a lease of the land hereinafter mentioned in perpetuity at the rent and upon and subject to the

I. THAT the Lessee shall and will duly pay annually in advance to the Colonial Treasurer of Our said State the rent hereby reserved at the dates appointed for payment of the same in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts without deduction or abatement on any account whatsoever *#Irrbinen* that if the said rent be not paid as aforesaid the Lessee shall pay to the Colonial Treasurer by way of penalty a sum calculated at such rate not to exceed Four per centum per annum as may be prescribed by the regulations under the said Acts for the time being in force or as may be fixed by the Commissioner.

- e. THAT the Lessee shall subject to and in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts reside on the said land and make it his bona fide residence.
 - 3. THAT the Lessee shall hold and use the said land bona fide for his own exclusive benefit.
- 4. THAT the Lessee will not use or permit to be used the said land for any purpose other than grazing
- 5. THAT the Lessee shall fence the external boundaries of the said land within such period and with such class of fencing as may be determined by the Commissioner and shall and will well and sufficiently repair and keep repaired the fence so to be erected during the residue of the terms of the Lease problem that boundaries common to the land hereby granted and to other lands (if any) held by the Lessee need not be fenced as long as such other lands and the land hereby lessed are held by the Lessee problem Also that the Commissioner shall not be entitled under this clause to require rabbit-proof fencing to be erected.
- 6. THAT the Lessee shall subject to and in accordance with the said Acts and the regulations thereunder pay all survey fees and interest thereon payable in respect of the subject land.
 - 7. THAT the Lessee shall-
 - (i) within such time as may be specified by the Commissioner take such steps and measures as the Commissioner shall direct to destroy rabbits dogs foxes and such other vermin and such weeds as may from time to time be declared noxious in the Government Gazette and to keep the said land free of such vermin and weeds during the currency of this Lease to the satisfaction of the Commissioner; and
 - (ii) as Our Minister for Lands of Our said State may from time to time direct foster and cultivate such edible shrubs and plants as the Commissioner may consider can be advantageously and successfully cultivated.

Birthinh that during the currency of this Lease the Lessee shall not be compelled to expend annually for the purposes of destroying vermin and weeds as aforesaid and for the purpose of cultivating edible shrubs as aforesaid a sum exceeding one-farthing per acre of the whole area under Lease such sum to be expended on any of the purposes aforesaid in such proportions and in such manner as the Commissioner may from time to time direct Birthinh Alsn that the Commissioner may at any time require proof from the Lessee of the expenditure of all moneys so expended on each or any of the purposes aforesaid the onus to be on the Lessee of proving such expenditure in each case.

- 8. THAT the Lessee shall keep and preserve sufficient timber on the said land for shade and firebreaks.
- 9. THAT the Lessee shall not interfere with the timber upon any State Forest, Forest Reserve, or Timber Reserve which may now or hereafter be included within the said land without the permission in writing of the Commissioner and shall not prevent any person or persons duly authorised in that behalf from cutting or removing timber upon such State Forest, Forest Reserve or Timber Reserve or upon the said land.
- 10. THAT the Lessee shall not ringbark cut or otherwise destroy or permit the destruction of any timber or edible scrub without the written consent of the Commissioner Brobind that the Lessee may use in such manner as the Commissioner may from time to time determine edible trees or scrub for stock feeding purposes and may take such timber and other material (not being within a State Forest Forest Reserve or Timber Reserve) as he may require for building and other purposes upon the land hereby leased.
- II. THAT the Lessee shall not obstruct or interfere with any reserves roads or tracks or the lawful use thereof by any person.
- 12. THAT the Lessee shall and will maintain and keep in reasonable repair all improvements on the said land during the currency of this Lease and shall and will permit Our Minister for Lands the Commissioner and any person authorised by Our said Minister or the Commissioner at all times to enter upon and examine the whole or any part of the demised land and the buildings and other improvements thereon.
- 13. THAT the Lessee shall furnish such returns or statements as the Commissioner may from time to time require in connection with any Lease or License or Freehold or Conditional Purchase held by him or in which he is interested within the Western Division or which are or is worked in conjunction with any Lease or License in the Western Division held by him or in which he is interested and in connection with any sheep or large stock cost of improvements working expenses or any other matter relative to any such holding as aforesaid.
- 14. THAT the Lessee shall not transfer convey assign or sublet the said land or any portion thereof or mortgage or charge the same with the repayment of moneys advanced on the security thereof without having first obtained the written consent of Our said Minister,
- 15. THAT the Lessee shall not grant any grazing rights over the said land or agist stock thereon without first having obtained such consent as aforesaid,
- 16. THAT the Lessee shall not overstock or permit or allow to be overstocked the land hereby demised and that the decision of the Commissioner as to what constitutes overstocking shall be final and that the Lessee shall comply with any directions of the Commissioner to prevent or discontinue overstocking.

17. THAT the Lessee shall permit any person duly authorised in that behalf to enter upon the said land and search for work win and remove all or any minerals metals gems precious stones coal or mineral oils in under or upon the said land.

18. Urobided Always and it is Wereby Agreed and Declared as follows :-

- (a) That no transfer or assignment of this Lease or any agreement to sublet the said land or any part thereof shall affect any forfeiture incurred or any debt or liability accrued to US OUR HEIRS OR SUCCESSORS under or by virtue of these presents;
- (b) That no transfer of this Lease shall be registered or recognised if any rent payment or other dues to the Crown are in arrear;
- (c) That no public rights now existing or hereafter to be created in and over any Travelling Stock Route Reserve or Camping Reserve which may be included within the said land shall be affected by the granting of this Lease;
- (d) That it shall be lawful for Our Governor of Our said State by notification to be published in the Government Gazette to withdraw from this Lease any lands required for mining purposes townships or any public purpose mentioned in or declared as such under the provisions of the Crown Lands Consolidation Act 1913 or any Act amending the same #rntided that upon such publication as aforesaid the Lessee shall be entitled to such compensation in respect of the land so withdrawn for the unexpired term of these presents and for the improvements owned by the Lessee upon the land so withdrawn as aforesaid as may be determined by Our said Minister after appraisement by the Commissioner.
- 19. Irribited Always and these presents are upon this express condition that if and whenever the rent hereby reserved or any part thereof shall be in arrear for more than six months after the time hereinbefore for the payment thereof appointed or whenever there shall be a breach or non-observance by the Lessee or his executors administrators and assigns of any other condition or provision herein contained or incorporated herewith and on the part of the Lessee to be observed and performed it shall be lawful for Our said Minister after report from the Commissioner to declare by notification in the Government Gazette that the Lease hereby expressed to be granted is cancelled and forfeited and thereupon these presents shall become of no effect and the term of the Lease hereby granted shall absolutely determine and Our said Minister may enter upon the said land and the Lessee or his executors administrators and assigns therefrom expel but without releasing the Lessee or his executors administrators or assigns from liability in respect of the breach or non-observance or non-performance of any covenant condition or stipulation herein contained or incorporated herewith.
- 20. **Brobided Hurther and it is Merchy Berlared** that such of the provisions and conditions of this Lease as require or prescribe any act or thing to be done or not to be done by the Lessee shall in addition to being read and construed as conditions of this Lease be also read and construed as covenant by the Lessee or his executors administrators and assigns with US OUR HEIRS and SUCCESSORS to observe and perform the said provisions and conditions.
- 21. The terms "Our Minister for Lands of Our said State" and "Our said Minister" when herein used shall mean and include Our Minister for Lands of Our said State for the time being or other Our Minister of Our said State for the time being charged with the administration of the said Acts.
